

Orygen is excited to embark on the next chapter that will bring to life our new home.

Our new building will transform the way we work and incorporate Orygen's values from the ground up! Not only is the new building designed by young people for young people, but will also be built by young people – with a Victorian Government guaranteed 10% minimum apprentices on site.

So please excuse the dust and noise that you may experience during your visit. We know the construction isn't ideal, but we feel fortunate to be able to stay open during the build so we can continue to serve our young people and visitors.

Your privacy is very important to us and so during the construction process we have taken extra measures to ensure we do all we can to uphold your privacy.

Orygen's Parkville site will be changing rapidly, so here is everything you need to know:

Getting to Orygen

Please allow extra time getting to the site as the traffic conditions have changed due to the relocation of the entrance driveway and installation of temporary traffic lights on site to direct cars.

New exits and entrances

With the fencing off of the front drive way, there will no longer be access to the main building through the front doors. A new entrance and reception area will be created by making some changes to the current reception area. To access the main building from the lower car park a new entrance will be created in Building C, new signage will be installed on site to direct people both to this entrance and exit, but also how to find reception.

A number of the existing entrances and exits on the front of the main building and Building C will no longer be in use.

Parking

Unfortunately less parking will be available on site due to the construction zone, which will see the loss of all of the parking in the front drive way and all of the first lower car park (which is the where the Construction teams offices will be located). However alternate parking is also available at The Royal Melbourne Hospital – Royal Park Campus or the Zoo, both on Poplar Road.

Disabled parking will be located at the drop off zone and the accessible entrance will be the first side door of the north corridor, just past the new reception entrance.
