The Research Manager will have primary responsibility for ensuring the coordination of MOST research projects and will be responsible for key administrative functions.

This position will require skills and experience in project management, research data collection and management, ethics processes and stakeholder engagement. The Research Manager will be an excellent communicator and comfortable managing multiple tasks, while being a strong team player with an aptitude for problem-solving. They will be expected to work with a high degree of autonomy under the general direction of the Head of Research, Orygen Digital.
